SIP/PNEK: Progress Toward 80/20

- Robert Wood Johnson Foundation announces initiative to support state efforts to transform care through nursing. The new program will strengthen 20 Future of Nursing Campaign for Action Coalitions across the country (Announced by RWJ March 19, 2013)
- Initiative goal is to aid states in preparing nursing to address pressing health care challenges including access, quality, and cost.

SIP/PNEK: Progress Toward 80/20

- Initiative provides Action Coalitions with two-year grants of up to \$150,000. Kansas is selected for full funding!
- Grant recipients will, “work to implement programs that prepare nurses to lead system change, strengthen nursing education, expand access to care by maximizing the use of nurses, recruit and train a more diverse nursing workforce, and improve quality and coordination of care.” (RWJ, March 19, 2013)

 - a. Develop and maintain infrastructure with inclusive network of stakeholders.
